Latest BREXIT update

We have been asked to share the information below with you.

EU citizens and their families (including non-EU citizens) who were resident in the UK by 31 December 2020, need to apply to the EU Settlement Scheme to continue to live, work and study in the UK beyond 30 June 2021. Each child must have their own application.

Some EU Nationals may not think EU Settled Status applies to them due to the length of time they have lived here and paperwork they already have. However, even if they have lived in the UK for many years or have a permanent residence document, they still need to apply.

It is essential that all EU Nationals apply for Settled Status, regardless of previous paperwork received. It is also essential that parents apply for each child as, in addition to other rights, EU Settled Status protects their child's right to access higher education. The deadline to apply for EU Settled Status is Wednesday 30 June.

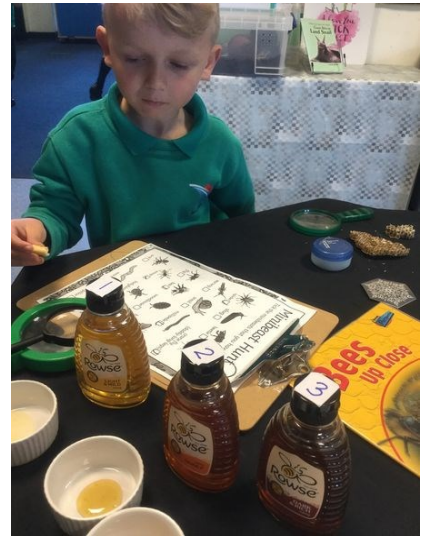
Thorpe St Andrew Giant Litter Pick

Fabulous Learning

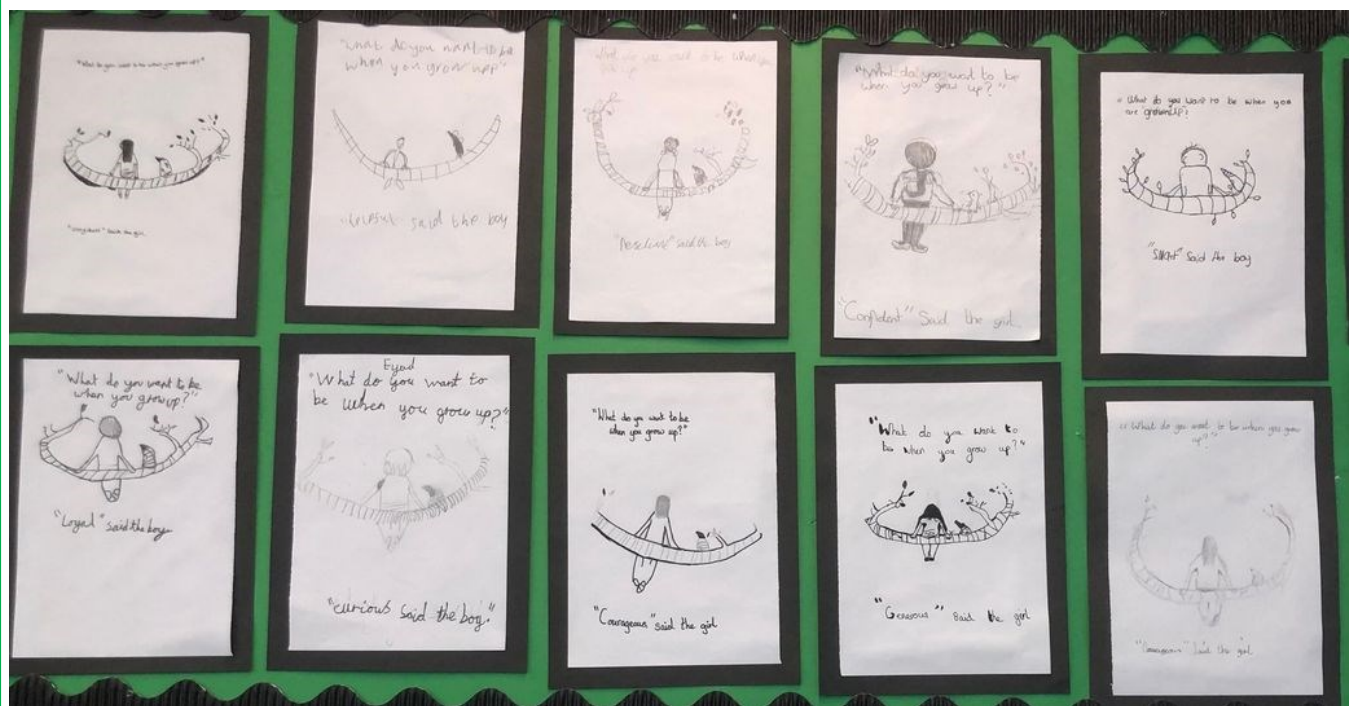
As part of Talk for Writing, The Sleepy Bumblebee, Year R pupils have been learning about bees and tasting honey!
