Pyjamarama Day - Friday 14th May



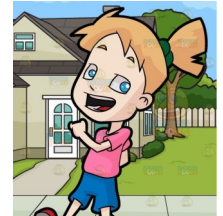

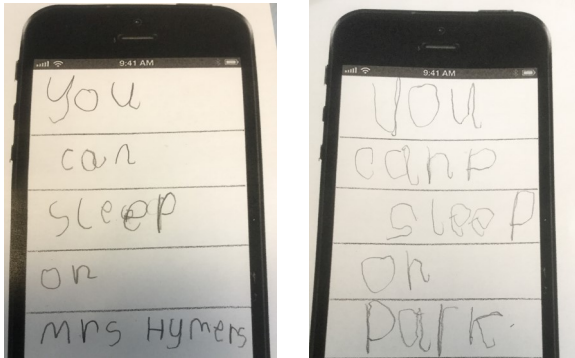
