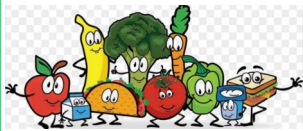

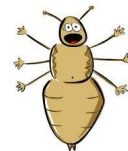


Year 2 have continued their Philosophy for Art project, by using paper mache to create a hard shell for their dragon eggs.
