# Welcome Back

Welcome back. We hope you had an enjoyable half term with your families. As we move through November, please continue to check the school website for the latest updates and the back page of this newsletter for diary dates.

## COVID-19 Update

Thank you for your continued support with the COVID-19 routines. In light of the governments announcement on Saturday 31st October please can we remind you of the following:

- The staggered drop off and pick up times must continue to be adhered too.
- Only one adult should bring and collect their children from school.
- The one way system remains in place, throughout the site, to eliminate groups passing on narrow pathways.
- Only send your child/ren to school with a tote bag, drawstring PE style bag or a carrier bag, please do not send in rucksacks.
- From tomorrow (Wednesday 4th November) we ask all adults entering the site, including
  playground, to wear a face mask unless they have a medical reason preventing them from
  doing so.
- We would also like to highlight that the current advice is to keep the school well ventilated to minimise risk. Whilst the heating is on, the windows will be open, so children may wish to bring additional layers to wear at school.
- From 4th November the school remains open for all pupils to attend. Staff will only set
  work via Google Classrooms or Tapestry for pupils whose 'bubble' is closed or that are selfisolating or shielding with a medical reason confirmed by a GP or hospital.

## Anti-Bullying Week 16th - 20th November

Anti-bullying Week, which takes place every November in conjunction with the Anti-bullying Alliance will be from 16th November until 20th November.

**Odd Socks day!** Children are invited to come to school on November 16th in their school uniform, but also wearing odd socks. 
# Assembly Theme - Collaboration
