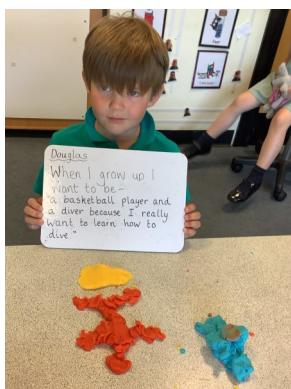
Walking to School



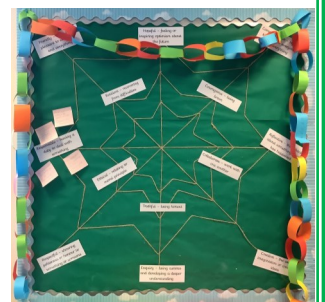
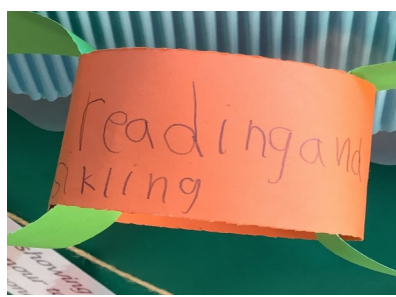
Thank you to all the parents and carers who help keep our pupils safe by parking at Sainsbury's before and after school and walking through.
