

Year 1 explore the meaning of the = symbol in maths.








Year 2 innovated a text to write a setting description.

Year 2 have also made emotional rollercoaster models where arh shape and/or colour represents a different








Year 3 comparing numbers using the greater and less than symbols.








Year 3 continuing their learning at home by baking bread.
