OPAL

In conjunction with OPAL, which won the best active schools' award programme in Europe, we are embarking on an exciting new project to make our play times even better. Last week pupils were introduced to the project and reflected on how they could be 'responsible' in their play, so that the actions keep themselves and others safe. They were introduced to the idea that some play types carry risk and began to think about different solutions to reduce risks so they can enjoy different types of play. Some of the school council members became 'Play Detectives', recording current types of play on the playground.

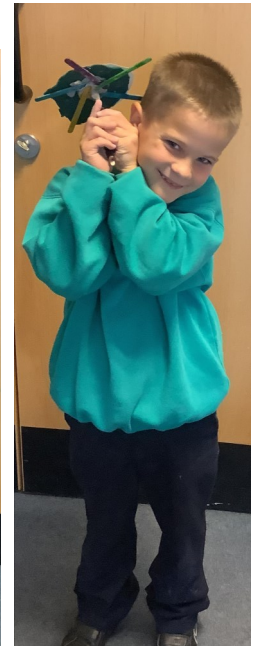


Engaging learning

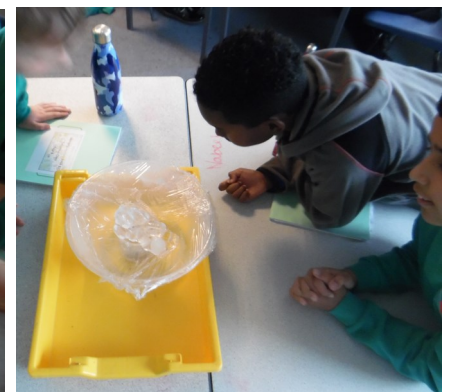
Reception have been busy in their new mud kitchen making 'porridge', 'chocolate cakes' and smoothies' to serve in their outdoor cafe!
