COVID-19 update

As you will be aware although the Government has removed the legal requirement to selfisolate following a positive COVID test it still advises people who test positive to stay at home. Adults and children who test positive are advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least five full days and then continue to follow the guidance until they have received two negative test results on consecutive days. The Yare Educational

Trust have provided the following statement:

'Children and young people with COVID-19 should not attend their education setting while they are infectious. They should take an LFD test from 5 days after their symptoms started (or the day their test was taken if they did not have symptoms) followed by another one the next day. If both these tests results are negative, they should return to their educational setting if they normally attend one, as long as they feel well enough to do so and do not have a temperature. They should follow the guidance for their educational setting. Children and young people who usually attend an education or childcare setting and who live with someone who has COVID-19 should continue to attend the setting as normal.

Danny Wallace Author Visit

On Thursday 3rd March, World Book Day, we are delighted to be welcoming the author and broadcaster Danny Wallace to talk to years 3,4 and 5 about his hilarious books. There will be an opportunity for children in these classes to purchase a book and get it signed by Danny during the afternoon. We would also like to invite parents into the hall at the end of the school day to



buy books and meet the author with their child. Books are priced at £6.99 and £7.99 and children may also use their £1 WBD token towards the cost.

Attendance

A reminder that the school gates will close promptly at 8.50am, as this is the time pupils are expected in class for registration and their morning learning begins. Lateness and absence can affect wellbeing and attainment. Attendance is monitored by our Safe-



guarding Lead, as absence from school is a potential safeguarding risk. Therefore, we encourage parents and carers to communicate with us as early as possible, circumstances which may affect absence or require support. Where attendance (excluding COVID-19 related) falls below 90% this is considered persistent absenteeism. Mrs Bailey will contact parents/carers to work together, where absence is falling, as part of our early intervention, in order to work together to maximise each child's school attendance.

Year R enjoying exploring their new outdoor play equipment.










As part of Talk for Writing, Year 1 explored different facts about a range of animals from the story 'Handa's Surprise'.












Year 3 enjoyed their Talk for Writing creative hook into persuasive writing - they visited the magical hat shop and made posters to persuade people to buy the hats.
