What are we learning this term?

Here's a quick summary of the topics we will be covering over the Summer Term:

Literacy: We will be writing an interesting and informative report.

Maths: We will be learning about time, mass and capacity.

History: We will learning about Ancient Egypt.

PE: Dynamic and static balance
