Our learning last term:

Last term we focused Fractions, Decimals and Percentages in Maths, and looked at identifying equivalent quantities. In Literacy, we learnt to write an adventure plot with a meeting tale, based on This Morning I Met a Whale. We began our learning about the Ancient Greeks, as well as learning a little Spanish. We created Ancient Greek wreaths that would have been worn by the winner of the Ancient Olympics.

What are we learning this term?

Here's a quick summary of the topics we will be covering over the Summer Term:

Literacy: We will be writing persuasive speeches and creating information texts.

Maths: We will be revisiting prior knowledge, interpreting data and statistics and looking at the properties of shape.

Computing: We will be looking at commands and programming.

Languages: We will be learning a little more Spanish.

Science: We will be focusing on plants and lifecycles.

DT: We will be designing and making our own Ancient Greek style pots.
