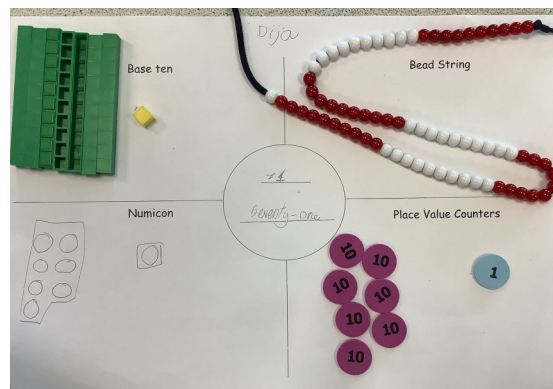
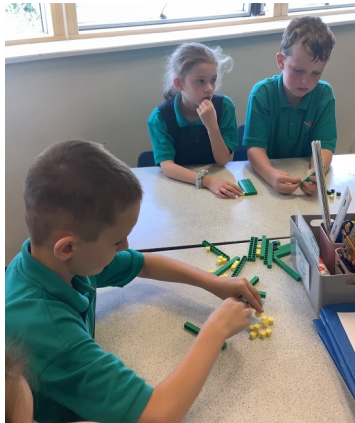
## Congratulations

Year 3 have been practising place value in maths.



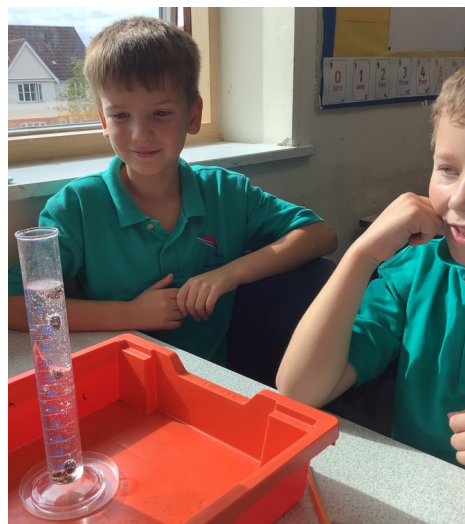
In R.E. they also enjoyed exploring the 'wow factor' of outdoors.

With this in mind we would like to create a foodbank for families in the Dussindale Community to have access to this year. The foodbank will be based at our school in the Family Room, which can be easily accessed via the front office. Once we have collected donations for our Foodbank, items can be collected from the Family Room from Wednesday 28th September onwards.
