Perhaps you could make your own map!</p>	<p>We are learning about Hinduism. Can you create your own Hinduism fact file with key facts about the religion?</p>	<p>Spend time listening to music at home. Can you make a list of songs with a fast tempo and those with a slow tempo? Which do you prefer?</p>
<p>We are focusing on ball skills in PE. Can you work on sending and receiving a ball with accuracy? This could be through throwing, catching, or passing with your feet.</p>	<p>In Science, we are learning about plants. We are observing runner beans growing. Can you grow a different plant at home or observe one changing in a garden or park you visit?</p>	<p>Can you create a shape poem using a whale's outline? It does not need to rhyme. You could write inside the outline or around the edge.</p>	<p>Can you practise telling the time to the hour and the half past on an analogue clock? Perhaps you could draw a clock and what you do at that time of day.</p>
