Phonics

Just a little reminder that the phonics screening check will be taking place for all Year 1 children during the week of June 12th. As per the homework grid, the most helpful thing you can do at home is read, read and read! This could be via your child's Sounds Write decodable book or through the phonics play website:

https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources where there are a range of free resources that you can access. We would particularly encourage you to practise reading words with split spellings in: a-e, e-e, i-e, o-e and u-e (cake, even, time, phone, tune) as these can be trickier to spot. Other sounds that can sometimes be seen as trickier to identify are:

'au' – haunt

'ir' - whirl

'ue' - glue

And 'aw' - straw.
