Following a successful career teaching in EYFS, Mrs Hymers has decided to retire at the end of August 2023. Although we will all miss her, we wish her a happy retirement.


As soon as we have confirmed who will be covering Miss Goodall and replacing Mrs Hymers as EYFS lead, we will update you.

In computing lessons, Year 1 have been learning to type on a keyboard and edit the size, font and colour of text.








In maths, Year 4 have been completing time puzzles, ordering 12 hours and 24 hour times.
