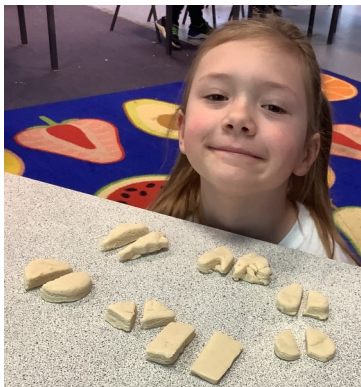
## Aspirational visit from World and European Champion Courtney Tulloch.

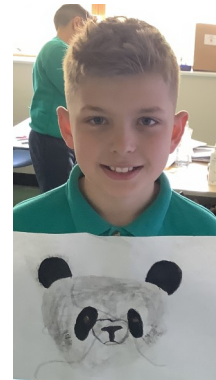
Year 1 enjoyed using play dough halves and quarters for fractions.
