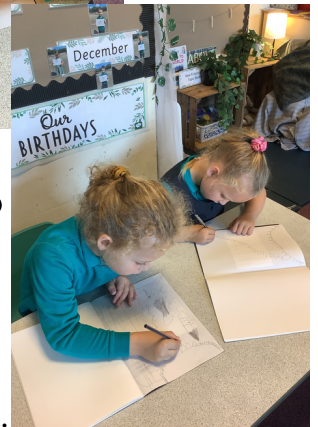
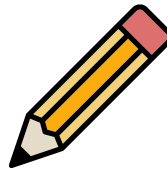
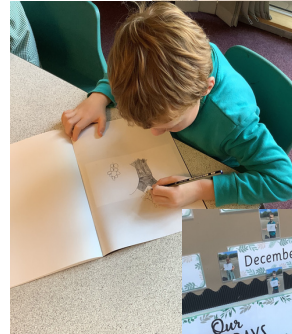
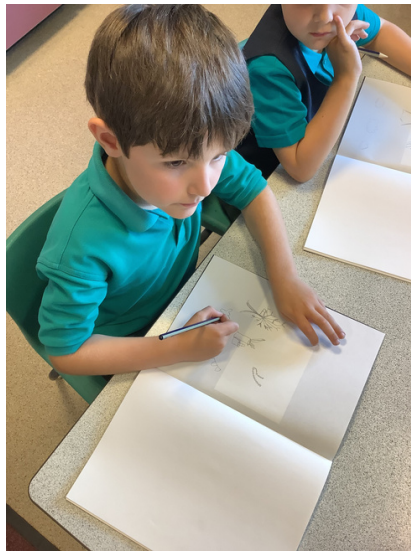
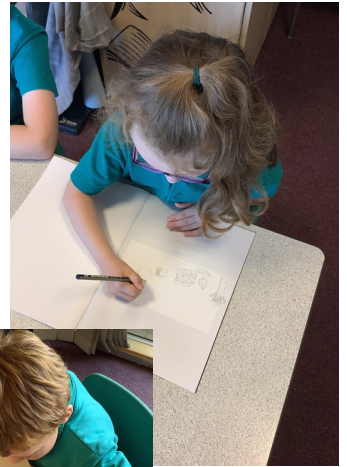
Obama Class have been busy learning about Barack Obama.
