What we're up to:

Talk for Writing

This half term, we will be looking at 'The Storm Whale' by Benji Davies in our Talk for Writing. We will learn the text by heart (imitate), change parts of it together (innovate) and then create our own stories using what we have learnt (invent). We will be trying a new method for gathering ideas for writing - using a double page spread, one for banking ideas and one for writing our full sentences.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths, we will begin to look at Place Value to 50, using what we already know about number bonds and applying this to larger numbers. We will be using manipulatives in class and looking at how numbers can be partitioned into tens and ones. We will also introduce multiplication and division and fractions.

Science: Plants

Geography: Climates and weather

RE: Hinduism

Music: Playing the boomwhackers

PE: Physical skills (sending and receiving)

PSHE: Relationships

DT: Textiles (making puppets)
