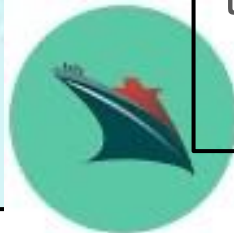

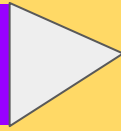


Experiences and Opportunities
