Pupil Feedback

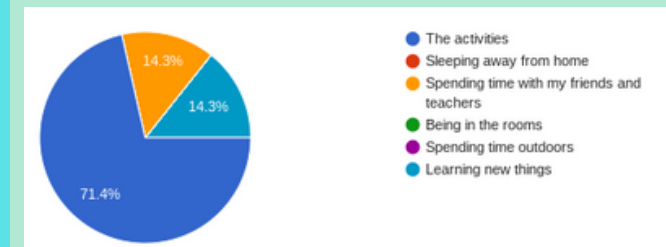
In May 2024, 42 Year 4 pupils attended a three day residential at Eaton Vale in Norwich. The children took part in various outdoor activities from canoeing, archery, den building, rope climbing, trapeze and buggy building.

The activities focused on developing their resilience, as well team building skills whilst having the opportunity to be independent, staying away from home for two nights.

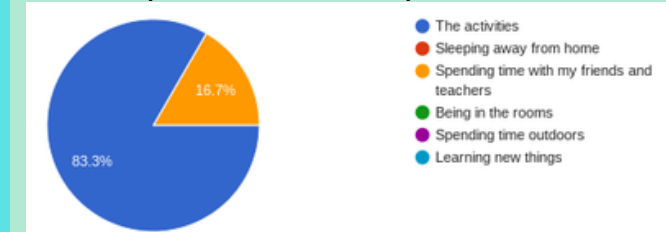


What did children say they enjoyed the most?

The most popular activities were backwards cooking, trapeze and canoeing.

Pupil feedback was taken from the same size sample of pupil premium and non pupil premium pupils on return to school.

All seven pupil premium attended the Year 4 residential, with pupil premium funding paying for 43% of PP pupils.

What did the children say?

- 100% of Pupil Premium children said attending Eaton Vale increased their confidence
- 100% of Non Pupil Premium children said that attending Eaton Vale increased their confidence

What did you learn Eaton Vale?

Pupil Premium Pupils said:

- That you don't always need your family with you
- I learnt how you can survive in the wild
- I learnt how to work with others
- How to overcome a fear
- How to climb high ropes
- I learnt how to paddle in a canoe
- How to start a fire safely

Non Pupil Premium Pupils said:

- That you can overcome your fears
- How to tie different knots
- You can face your fears and overcome them
- That it is safe to these activities as the adults are trained
- I learnt how to paddle a canoe



What are you most proud of?

I jumped off the platform when I did the trapeze.

I did the climbing challenge because I am scared of heights.

That I did everything and I didn't quit.

I got to the top of the trapeze-I was scared at the top but I jumped off.

I was able to canoe really fast and I didn't think I would be able to do it.

I faced my fear of small spaces

I was proud of being able to get to the top of the ladder and jump off.



How has going to Eaton Vale helped you?

86% of Pupil Premium Pupils said that the residential had helped them. They gave the following responses:

- It has made me feel more confident in class
- It has helped me be more independent
- It made me believe in myself more



100% of Non Pupil Premium Pupils said that the residential had helped them. They gave the following responses:

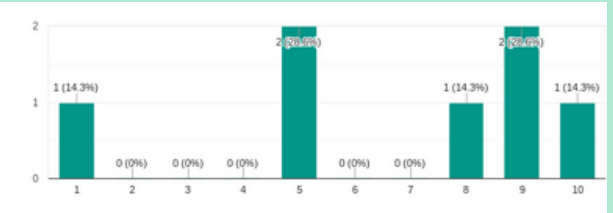
- I have more belief in myself

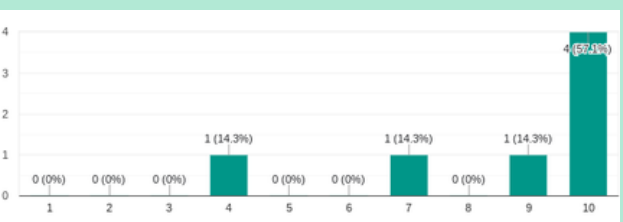

After

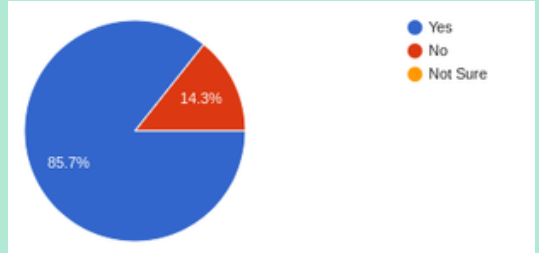
Pupil Premium Children:

 16%-Sad (to leave)

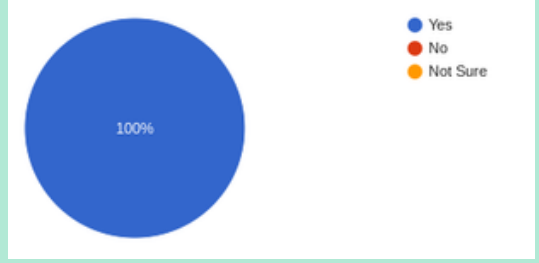


If offered the opportunity to take part in a residential in Year 6 would you like to attend?
