### **International Food Festival Friday 14th June**

This year, pupils will have the opportunity to take part in 'The Day of Welcome' on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June. The aim for the day is for pupils to build a culture of welcome and understanding for people seeking sanctuary. During the day pupils will learn to:

- Think about what 'home' means to us
- Understand that home can mean many different things
- Celebrate our different homes

On Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June, we would like to invite parents and carers to help us with this event as we would like to create an international food event after school 4 - 5.30 pm. The event invites parents and carers to provide samples of food from different cultures which other families can then try after school.

The recommendation is that parents providing a sample of food for up to twenty, can then try other samples for free. Whilst those who do not provide a sample, can still take part, but will be required to pay £2 for adults and £1 for children under 12 to try different food.

Whilst parents and carers layout their food samples for others to try after school, families attending can remain on site for a 'Stay and Play' session.

Any parents and carers planning to provide samples of food, should email the school office, so we know to expect them. Money raised from the event will go towards purchasing resources to make Dussindale Primary School a 'School of Sanctuary'.
