Discussed:

-Whole school assembly: Digi-Leads are keen to lead a whole school assembly. ZW suggested one for Safer Internet Day in February which may be live or virtual. Ideas include:

- scavenger hunt to deliver the key message of SID
- Reminding pupils that Computer use in school is monitored by HT & DHT
- Informing pupils about what we should do if we are asked to meet someone online
- Cyberbullying poster challenge - Digi leads judge them - house token and prize (sweets) and display the best posters from EYFS, KS1 and LKS2, UKS2 alongside the Digi-Lead display board by hall

-E-safety newsletter - ZW asked digi-leads to consider ideas of content to include for Autumn Term 2 e-safety newsletter. Some suggestions included:

- Typing game - (dance mat typing)
- Games - safety online - minecraft (trading if know how) Roblox (polite messages only if know)
- Challenges -accessing the computing challenges in lessons

- Supporting pupils in Computing lessons in their own classes & taking care of resources
